MAINTENANCE WORKER - PUBLIC WORKS

NATURE OF WORK

This is routine manual labor and equipment operation activities involved in the construction, maintenance, and repair of parks, streets, utilities, or other public facilities. Work involves responsibility for performance of a variety of heavy and light manual tasks. Assignments may include the use of standard or specialized hand tools, power-operated devices, or other equipment. Assignments also include the operation of trucks and other automotive or construction equipment incidental to regular duties. Position is subject to call backs, unscheduled overtime, shift work, and weekend duty. Performs duties in conformance with applicable safety and security standards. Work is performed under the direction of the Foreman, and results are checked for adherence to instruction and conformance with established standards.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

All Departments:

- 1. Performs a variety of heavy and light manual labor duties in the construction, maintenance, and repair of parks, streets, utilities, and other public works municipal facilities.
- 2. Operates standard and specialized hand tools, power operated devices and other equipment in a safe, efficient, and proficient manner, without undue wear or damage.
- 3. Conducts routine check of equipment prior to and after operation to ensure equipment is in operating condition; records operating data and repair services needed.
- 4. Operates equipment as assigned in a safe, efficient, and proficient manner without undue wear or damage.
- 5. Reports all equipment maintenance needs using a vehicle repair order to Vehicle Maintenance Supervisor or immediate supervisor. Reports all equipment damage and accidents to immediate supervisor.
- 6. Reports maintenance needs and work progress to immediate supervisor.
- 7. Maintains operational records.
- 8. Performs other duties related to the position as assigned.

Parks Department:

This department provides for the maintenance and operation of public buildings and grounds, open spaces, trails, and parks.

- 9. Installs, constructs, and maintains parks, open spaces, and trails.
- 10. Performs landscaping, grounds care, forestry, and naturalist duties.
- 11. Prepares parks and facilities for recreation program use including setting up and taking down equipment, dragging ballfields, pool maintenance, lining fields, and flooding and maintaining ice rinks.
- 12. Performs general facilities maintenance activities including interior and exterior building maintenance and repair.

Sewer and Water Department:

This department provides for the maintenance, operation, installation, construction, and repair of the city's water distribution and sewer facilities.

- 13. Operates and/or maintains water systems including water storage tank, water mains, valves, fire hydrants, and pumps.
- 14. Responds to emergency calls and inspects system for leaks or back-up and determines corrective action.
- 15. Operates and/or maintains storm and sanitary sewer systems, including lift stations, retention ponds, sewer mains, manholes, generators, catch basins, and pumps.
- 16. Operates and/or troubleshoots utility SCADA system.
- 17. Locates and marks underground utilities as requested by contractors and property owners.

Street Department:

This department provides for the maintenance, construction, and repair of city streets, and trails.

- 18. Installs, repairs, and maintains streets, alleys, bridges, parking lots, and sidewalks.
- 19. Plows streets, parking lots, and sidewalks.
- 20. Trims trees and conducts tree inspections.
